The 2004 Urziger Wurzgarten Riesling Kabinett A.P. #6 exudes aromas of cider, fresh strawberry and key lime, along with a faintly beer-like note of CO2 and yeast. Luscious and juicy if quite sweet and suggestively creamy on the palate, it is nevertheless a true Kabinett in its lightness and lilt, and pours on the strawberry and key lime with tart berry, tingling citrus zest and diverse mineral notes adding interest. Cider, strawberry, cinnamon, and mineral salts finish this very attractive picture of what the new generation at Berres can do.

The 2004 Urziger Wurzgarten Riesling Spatlese A.P. #8 is redolent of kiwi, lightly-cooked strawberry, and key lime. Creamier and richer than the corresponding Kabinett, this also reveals faintly oily, estrous, honeyed notes of apparent botrytis. While undeniably cut from excellent cloth of good length, it just misses the vividly fresh fruit character and delicate balance of the Kabinett.

In keeping with its fine balance of fresh and lightly botrytised fruit expressions, this Riesling combines juiciness with faint oiliness on the palate. It finishes with tastes of honey, candied citrus and melon rinds, and brown spices, harboring an unobtrusive hint of bitterness.
